### Pre-Cast Window Cills

Important for both structural and aesthetic reasons, a precast concrete window cill keeps rainwater away from the window frame and also supports the window. Cills will be sloped so water is directed away from the window, and will also have a drip channel on the underside to prevent water from running down the wall of the building.


#### Stooled and Non Stooled Window Cill

A stooled window cill is used when the building has an exposed brickwork finish. Stooling enables the brickwork to sit flush on the cill. For most other finishes a non stooled cill would be used and this will generally extend beyond the window opening.

Here at Attlebridge we produce a wide range of cills. We offer a standard 140 x 150 profile, but also make bespoke cills to your exact specification.
