Within our production process, our waste is closely monitored. We record wastage figures every day, and always try to limit these numbers as much as possible.

All unused and obsolete steel is recycled with EMR Group, locally in Lenwade. Our solid concrete waste goes away to be crushed and reused through Raymond McLeod Farms Ltd, while our general waste is taken away by Norman Wenn Waste Management. 99% of this general waste will be diverted from landfill. Any chemical waste that we may have is dealt with by certified waste disposal firm, Ellaway Environmental Ltd.

We continue to look at ways to improve our waste management and keep our company as green as possible.
